HISTORY School of Management

Management studies have long been offered at the Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM). Management courses were offered by the School of Social Sciences since the 70's. Owing to its popularity, a Management major was introduced in 1978. Approximately 10 years later the Bachelor of Management degree was offered and that marked the start of a concerted effort to form a separate entity to run the management programmes. The dream was realised when the School of Management (SOM) was established on the 1st. of December 1989 and SOM embarked on her illustrious journey offering undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Initially, the Bachelor of Management degree had five areas of specialization namely: Accounting; Finance; Marketing; Operations Management; and Organizational Behavior. At the time, SOM's philosophy was to produce competent managers. Subsequently there was a growing need for the Accounting Programme coupled with the nation's critical call for qualified accountants have persuaded SOM to offer the Bachelor of Accounting degree with effect from the 1999/2000 academic session. The entire curriculum for this degree was designed in close collaboration and consultation with the Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA) and many other professional accounting bodies.

The efforts of the entire SOM's community were cowned with success when in 2003, the Ministry of Education bestowed the honour of being the best School of Business Management and Accounting in the country. This recognition was based on an academic audit undertaken by a few professors from a consortium of the Institutes of Higher Learning New Zealand in collaboration with a local audit firm, Atarik Kamil and Company. As quality education is SOM's ultimate objective, various other professional bodies were invited to assess its curricula and instructional strategies. These efforts culminated in the accreditation of the Accountancy Programme by the MIA in October 2000. Soon after that, other professional bodies (MICPA, ACCA, CIMA, and CPA Australia) followed suit.

Over the years, SOM has grown and transformed creatively since her inception. Most recent, SOM launched the International Business Programme, which became the sixth area of specialization for the Bachelor of Management degree. Providing excellent education is not confined to undergraduate programmes. SOM's postgraduate programmes have continued to earn the reputation as a viable education path for mature students. The diversity of disciplines provide opportunities for students from different backgrounds to pursue their graduate studies notably the executives and managers working in the many multinationals in Penang and the Northern region. More importantly, the programmes are attracting candidates from all parts of the world such as the U.S.A, Middle East, China, Europe (Norway, Sweden, Finland), Canada, Australia, Japan, Indonesia, India, Nigeria, Pakistan, Bangladesh.

In addition, SOM has also made an impact in research and graduate education. Besides having their research published and cited in top-tier international journals, SOM's faculty members are also invited as visiting professors to universities within the region and around the globe. In addition, some professors act as advisors and consultants to various bodies nationally and internationally.

Further, in her bid to be more appealing to the industry, SOM had initiated the Executive Development Programme (EDP), which is catered for the executives from both the public and private sectors. To date, SOM has conducted various executive training to such institutions as Siemens, Unico, PDC, Bank Rakyat, PNB, UDA, Pentex, Intel Penang and Dell Asia Pacific.

With more than 6,000 of her graduates currently in the nation's workforce, SOM has nurtured strategic alliances with both the public and private enterprises such as UEM, FMM, and IBM. The latest collaboration is with Motorola. Such collaboration and participation are implemented through student practical training and the involvement of SOM's faculty in research and consultancy work. Thus establishing niche expertise in various fields. As a consequence, SOM has been chosen by several foreign universities to host their international programmes.





The Bachelor of Management degree programme, USM, was introduced in the 1984/1985 academic session, as one of the degree programmes offered by the School of Social Sciences. In December 1989, the management section under the School of Social Sciences became an academic school on its own, i.e. the School of Management. Over the past 15 years the school has enjoyed huge success. It was named the best school in the teaching of management and accounting in the year 2003. It was based on the result of a survey commissioned by the Ministry of Higher Education to a Consortium of Professors from New Zealand in collaboration with a local auditing company, Atarik & Company. Other measures of achievements are the employability of its graduates by multinational companies and the big 4 audit firms and the high reception of practitioners on the activities run and managed by the school. The success story of the School of Management continues with its improvement efforts by constantly changing and coordinating its curriculum.

Bachelor of Accounting


The Bachelor of Accounting Degree programme was first offered in the 1999/2000 academic session. The Bachelor of Accounting degree graduates are recognised by the Malaysian Institute of Accountants [MIA]. This recognition means that the graduates will be accepted as Certified Accountants after gaining 3 years working experiences at an accountingfirm or industry. This programme received MIA accreditation on 30 September 2000. Assuch, graduates of the programme can apply to become Chartered Accountants after gaining a 3-year working experience in the field ofaccounting or a related field.


The postgradute students in all programmes will undertake a research dissertation in the following areas which fall under the School's Research Clusters:

- 1. **Enterprise Governance** some typical topics include: Board composition and members' succession; CEO succession; multiple directorship; monitoring intensity; the role of watchdogs; role of institutional investors, disclosure issues financial, non-financial, voluntary; audit committee effectiveness; ownership structure
- 2. **Leadership and Work Values** some typical topics include: Leadership/managerial styles (in the broadest application); leadership behavior; work centrality; work values attitudes (job satisfaction, commitment, QWL); personal-organizational values congruence/fit; power-influence approach; organizational behavior; human resource management; strategic management; leader-member exchange (LMX) supervisor-subordinate relationship; cross-cultural studies; gender issues; ethical decision making

- 3. **Technology Management** some typical topics include: Strategic/long-term issues relating to technology; process of Technological Innovations; R&D management, R&D Infrastructure & Technological change; product/process life cycles; technology transfer; technology risk analysis; quality & productivity issues; electronic organization; digital technology; knowledge management; product/process technology; information technology
- 4. **Financial Market-Based Research** some typical topics include: Ownership structure and firm value; derivatives pricing; behavioral finance; price reaction in IPOs and seasoned equity issue; risk measures and stock returns; market efficiency and stock performance; pricing issues and asset allocation; financial crisis and exchange rate exposure; anomalies, speculation and rationality; dividend policy and firm behavior; determinants of capital structure choice; corporate and financial restructuring; firm size and seasonal effect;pPredicting financial distress and shareholder wealth; M&A and corporate change
- 5. **Consumer Market-Based Research** some typical topics include: Customer satisfaction with product and services, complaint behavior; green movement; Halal issues; government policies; product development and policies; Internal marketing; managing marketing relationship; philosophy of marketing management; changes in marketing and consumer taste due to technological advancement; consumer behavior in buying; selection of brand name, shopping location, lifestyle
- 6. **Internationalization some typical topic** include: Strategies for entering markets; adaptation of marketing strategies; country of origin issues; strategic alliance.






Two programs are currently in collaboration with Sekolah Ikhtisas Tentera Udara (SITU) and School of Management are:


